WHA CEO/Trustee Education Session

The WHA Annual Trustee Education Session is quickly approaching and will be held in Lander on May 17. The Trustee Education Council has put together a great agenda and it promises to be a full day.

The day will start off with breakfast and then the Wyoming Hospital Association has engaged Kurt Mosley from Merritt Hawkins to present important information on poverty and uncompensated care, as well as a second session about physician and CEO burnout. Merritt Hawkins is one of the WHA Resources, Inc. endorsed vendors and is a national premier physician recruiting firm.

There will also be an informative legislative panel discussion where attendees will have the opportunity to visit with both chairmen from the Labor, Health and Social Services Committee, Senator Charlie Scott and Representative Eric Barlow.
